- Keep your septic system healthy! Remember to switch your drain field every 6 months.
- They are beautiful, but the geese at the lake are a nuisance. PLEASE DO NOT FEED THEM!
- Residents and their guests are welcome to fish in the lake. Please follow the catch and release policy. This policy provides an opportunity for others to enjoy fishing by allowing more fish to remain and reproduce.
- Warmer weather means many young residents will be playing outside. Please watch for them.
- When walking your pet around the lake and common areas please pick up after them and always keep them leashed. Read more in <u>Covenants Corner</u> below.
- There is no swimming allowed in the lake...that includes dogs. Please refrain from allowing your pets in the lake.

### <u>Covenants Corner</u>

Covenants govern land and properties in our community, are enforceable by legal action, and binding not only to the original owner, but also to subsequent buyers of the property.

#### Article I - Section 2 – Restrictions - (h) Animals

...no animals shall be permitted in any portion of the Common Areas except on a leash...the Board has the right to levy fines and enforcement charges against persons who do not clean up after their pets.

## Mailbox Maintenance

Each home in Heather Lake is required to have an approved mailbox that is maintained appropriately. If your mailbox needs to be replaced, you can purchase a new one at Cedar Craft Products, Inc., <u>www.cedarcraft.com</u> or (614) 759-1600. The mailbox is called the "Duffey" with reference code #HLK7/Q1B Heather Lake. The price to remove and replace (providing no concrete involved) is \$296.44 plus tax. If your mailbox just needs painted, the approved paint is Benjamin Moore Annapolis Gray and can be purchased at Fairfield Paint, 3032 Columbus Lancaster Road in Lancaster.

All mailboxes need to be in compliance by September 30, 2021.

Rounds from a handgun, rifle, or shotgun can travel a mile or more, and a ricochet can travel hundreds of yards. Please be mindful of your neighbor's safety and avoid the use of firearms within our subdivision. Thank you.
